

- Do you intend to or have you resigned from Emirates as a pilot?
- Are you current with your membership to the API Trust?
- Have you maintained 3 years of uninterrupted contributions to API just prior to resigning from Emirates?

If any answer is no, you are not eligible

YES to all three questions

BOX 1

Provide API with the following documents within 90 days prior to your Last Day of Service with Emirates:

- A valid Class 1 Medical Certificate issued by an FAA AME (GMC Clinics provide this in Dubai).
- A valid Class 1 Medical Certificate issued by the UAE GCAA.
- Signed copy of the API Rules.

You must remain current with your contributions.

BOX 2

API Membership temporarily suspended when you submit notification to Emirates of your intention to resign until documents in Box 3 are received.

BOX 4

Your API Membership remains current until you:

- Resign from API.
- Reach your 65th birthday.
- Fail to pay your contributions
- Submit notification to the air carrier of your resignation as a pilot (See Box 5).

BOX 3

API Membership resumes when the Trustee receives the following documents:

- A Valid Class 1 Medical Certificate from your current air carrier or regulator.
- A signed letter of employment stating you are employed as a pilot at an air carrier.
- Employment/Residence visa from the country where you are employed unless you are employed in your country of nationality.

BOX 5

When you submit notification to the air carrier of your resignation as a pilot and are moving to another air carrier as a pilot:

- Your membership will be temporarily suspended.
- You must remain financially current and the same procedures in Box 3 will apply.
